We follow an inquiry-based approach for teaching and learning. Students are encouraged to ask questions, discover problems related to real life situations, and establish links between known to unknown.

Apart from permitting students to demonstrate learning, the purpose of these assessments is also to permit teachers to review their curricula and revisit units if need be. Assessment rubrics will be shared with students by the respective teachers.
